## Principal's Report-Dr. Karim Shortridge

- Return to in-person learning: Staff has been very involved to in planning in-person learning for March 1<sup>st</sup>. Some classroom are set up for 6 or 12 student for social distancing, Wednesday will still be a support day for students
    - Phase I: E Group (student enrolled in special education services) and student who need additional support in small group setting. Approximately 400 invites were sent to student for 5-days in class learning.
    - Phase II: Pre K to 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students
    - Phase III: Hybrid option 1 or 2 days a week/March 29: 9<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade student I return
    - Phase IV: April 12<sup>th</sup> 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade student return
    - March 1<sup>st</sup> -Schedule Change: 7:45 AM to 2:30 PM (85 minute block classes)
    - Phone calls to parent who have not complete the survey
  - Q&A for Dr. Shortridge:
    - Q: Michelle Wineberg-how will student be mandated to wear masks  
A: No guidance form central office. RHS will mandate mask wearing, violators will return to virtual learning.
    - Q: What is the protocol if someone test positive at school  
A: Still evolving policy
    - Q: Will school have PPE for students  
A: Bus Driver and school will have extra, students are require bring their own
    - Q: Will teachers have the option to work from home if they have not taken vaccine  
A: Still working on CDC protocol for in-person learning
    - Q: What's in place for student during change classes  
A: Teachers will monitor students during transaction between classes
